### White Wine Flight

#### Medium Dry Riesling, Polka Dot, Pfalz

The bouquet is a symphony of citrus, very inviting. Clear fruit flavors rise easily: green apple, lime, citrus, some minerality and a long and clean finish.

#### Sauvignon Blanc, Whitehaven, Marlborough

Full-flavored wine with vibrant currant-leaf and gooseberry aromas and a hint of ripe citrus. This wine refreshes the palate with a crisp, clean, lingering finish.

#### Chardonnay, Frei Brothers, Sonoma

A traditional Sonoma Chardonnay style, possessing expressive fruit-forward characters and displaying intense varietal aromas and flavors, this Chardonnay showcases a round mouth-feel, orange zest and bright acidity.

### Red Wine Flight

#### Merlot, Red Rock, California

This wine opens with aromas of blackberry, raspberry and ripe cherry. Delicate vanilla aromas hint at the oak nuances, which give this wine its soft, round tannins.

#### Shiraz, McWilliam's, S.E. Australia

The supple yet generous palate is dominated by rich plum and raspberry fruit flavors with hints of spice and vanilla. The wine is soft and well balanced with a lingering fruit focused finish.

#### Zinfandel, 7 Deadly Zins, Lodi

Loaded with berry fruit, pepper, spice, and earth characteristics. A rich, full-bodied, opulent and luscious Zinfandel.

### Michigan Wine Flight

#### Ship of Fools, Chateau Grand Traverse

Medium-full bodied, bone dry and yet rich at the same time, with excellent intensity, bracing acidity and good length on the finish.

#### Chardonnay, Leelanau Cellars "Tall Ship"

Flavorful and aromatic with floral, mineral, grapefruit, and pear hints laced with subtle oak flavors, well balanced with firm acidity.

#### Silhouette Red Blend, Chateau Grand Traverse

Off-dry, fruity and rich in body with subtle mellowing from aging in new and seasoned French and American oak barrels.
