



What to Bring and How to Plan?

Bring as much of your own cropping supplies and equipment as you can comfortably carry.

Check with your friends about sharing equipment and assigning each person to bring something different. Always plan more pages than you think you can finish.

You may surprise yourself.

We will have the following available-

1. The Inspiration Station scrapbook store from Ovid, Michigan (www.ovidinspirationstation.com)
 - Accu-cut Diecut machine, Scanner
 - Epson Photo printer - price varies by size, up to 13x9
 2. Other Vendors – check our website for updates
 3. TLC (Top Line Creations) vendor (www.scrap-a-holics.com)
 4. Scrapbook magazines for ideas
 5. Computers and printer for journaling
 6. Each person gets 8 -ft. of working area
 7. (1) lamp on each table. **You're more than welcome to bring additional lighting and extension cord for your 8' table space.**
- Cash/Checkbook/Credit Cards- shop with the vendors or add extra classes.
 - Plan ahead- what project you want to do and pack accordingly.
 - Comfy clothes. Bring a sweater or sweatshirt (layered is best because of fluctuating temperatures in room).
 - Seat Cushion (chairs can get hard after a few hours)
 - Camera & extra camera battery (take pictures of your new friends and remember all the fun you had!)
 - Ziploc Baggies or envelopes for all those die cuts or punches you will make. If you bring the 2-gallon size they will be big enough to accommodate 12x12 paper.
 - **Miscellaneous items:** Medication, lotion, tissues, band aids, baby wipes
 - A great tool to buy is a wire shelf that can usually be found at Wal-Mart, Target, etc. in the household section. This is a great way to maximize our space since you can store items on top and under the shelf on your table.
 - Another product is a kitchen tool caddy or turnabout. This way you have those items you use most often right at your fingertips.



- In case your things get misplaced, you may want to put your name on all your belongings.
- Business cards or address labels- you are going to make lots of new friends.
- Swimsuit- enjoy a break in our pool or Jacuzzi

Frequent Questions & Answers

What time can we arrive?

Hotel check-in at the resort is 5:00pm. For the all-inclusive and local scrappers, the scrapbook area opens at 12:00pm on Friday, with snacks beginning at 3:00pm. The vendors will be open at 3pm.

Are tables assigned?

Tables are not assigned. If you arrive before the rest of your group does, you can reserve tables in your area. Most tables will be configured in groups of two so we can tape down all the extension cords. When you arrive, you can re-configure them into groups of 3 and 4, ONLY if they do not interfere with the space of the next scrapper.

Will there be snacks/beverages?

There will be snacks available at designated times...Chips and dips, chocolate candy, vegetables & dip, whole fruit. The beverage station of Coke products, Coffee & Water will be available 24 hours. You're more than welcome to bring your own snacks. The Slopeside Lounge will be available with a limited menu, as well as for cocktail service.

Will there be tools available, and product to buy?

Yes! The vendors will have tools available at their booth. They will provide lots of product, with sales throughout the weekend.

Is the crop room open all night?

Yes! You are able to scrap whenever you want to, so you can come and go when you want (the all inclusive scrapper). The building is secured.

Do we need to bring a light?

We will provide 1 desk lamp per 8 ft. table. You may bring additional lighting – if you do, we recommend you bring your own extension cord.

How should I dress?

We recommend you dress comfy, and bring a sweatshirt

Can we enjoy the resort amenities?

Absolutely! We have an outdoor heated pool at the Main Lodge Hotel. There is also an exercise room. Take a break and enjoy our complimentary chairlift ride. Hours are limited. Bring a camera! The view is breathtaking.
