 <p><b>TYPE I</b></p> <p>Cautious skiing on smooth slopes of gentle to moderate pitch.</p>	<p>Skiers not classified as Types I or III.</p> <p><b>TYPE II</b></p>	 <p><b>TYPE III</b></p> <p>Fast skiing on slopes of moderate to steep pitch.</p>
<p>Skiers who designate themselves as Type I receive lower than average release/retention settings. This corresponds to an increased risk of inadvertent binding release in order to gain releasability in a fall. This Type also applies to entry-level skiers uncertain of their classification.</p>	<p>Skiers who designate themselves as Type II receive average release/retention settings appropriate for most recreational skiing.</p>	<p>Skiers who designate themselves as Type III receive higher than average release/retention settings. This corresponds to decreased releasability in a fall in order to gain a decreased risk of inadvertent binding release. Type III settings should not be used by skier less than 22kg/48lbs.</p>
