# The Alpine

Boyne Mountain – Est. 1970



The Alpine is home of the 'Tournament of Champions', an invitation-only event, that is considered one of the Michigan PGA Majors.

From the opening tee shot at the peak of Boyne Mountain, to the demanding finish that may be one of the best in northern Michigan, the Alpine is a constant blend of beauty and playability.

# The Monument

Boyne Mountain – Est. 1985



The Monument golf course is a collection of dramatic and challenging golf holes of widely varying character, reflecting the distinct design philosophies of such noted architects as Donald Ross, Dr. Alister MacKenzie, Robert Trent Jones, George Fazio, and Pete Dye.

The course is dedicated to great golf course architecture and to those who have left lasting imprints on the game. Holes are dedicated to these players and

contributors to the game of golf, making the Monument a unique, playable Hall of Fame.

At the 2008 Tournament of Champions, a team of competitors sought out and broke the record for the fastest round of golf, completing 18 holes in 7 minutes and 56 seconds! The feat is recognized as the fastest ever by the Guinness Book of World Records.

Perched on bluffs high above the Bay Harbor community is Crooked Tree Golf Club. The course was sculpted from centuries-old hardwoods with the back nine opening to breathtaking views of Little Traverse Bay and Lake Michigan.

The course is famous for its undulating greens which are well protected and feature giant slopes and multiple tiers. The par-3 second hole has three levels to its putting surface, making for a great challenge that requires equal parts creativity and humility.

The back nine, which measures almost 400 yards longer than the front, starts out with one of BOYNE's most difficult par-4's; the 472 yard tenth hole. Two good shots are required to have a chance at par, especially with a hard sloping green to finish.

While there are tee shots that appear to be blind, the entire course has generous fairways and is as playable as it is exciting.

**The Quarry** – Winding its way around and through an immense shale quarry, the Quarry is complete with a 40 foot gorge, stone cliffs, natural ponds, and a gentle waterfall. This Arthur Hills masterpiece finishes with dramatic flair down to and along the shore of Lake Michigan.

**The Preserve** – The natural beauty of the Preserve is a haven for wildlife and golfers alike. Stately hardwoods tower over lush grasses, wildflowers and wetlands—all within an earshot of the Lake Michigan shores. The final hole opens up to a breathtaking shoreline vista.

# The Moor

Boyne Highlands – Est. 1974



The Moor is known for its unique design which features numerous doglegs. The front nine is advantageous for the right handed power fade-hitter, as holes 1, 2, 7 and 9 all bend from left to right off the tee. The two par-5's on the front side invite you to risk losing a shot at the reward of saving one.

The back nine opens with one of the most challenging par-4 holes at BOYNE, a tight driving hole with 3 separate ponds situated on the left and right sides of the fairway and another in front of the green.

The par-5 18th is a great finishing hole in the classic BOYNE tradition. This means one last water hazard to clear. Did you know that there is a water hazard on the 18th hole at all 8 of the BOYNE courses?

Every July, the best young players in the world converge on the Moor's 6814-yard layout for the American Junior Golf Association's Coca-Cola Junior All-Star Championship at Boyne Highlands.

# The Ross

Boyne Highlands – Est. 1989



The Donald Ross Memorial is a compilation of classic golf holes designed by Donald Ross recreated at BOYNE from some of the architect's most renowned courses.

The inspiration to seek and select classic Ross designed holes that would fit the existing terrain led to an odyssey of thousands of miles traveled and years of effort. A round of golf on the Ross contains the history and heritage of 3 Ryder Cups, 8 U.S.

Amateurs, 11 PGA Championships, and 14 U.S. Opens.

Yardage of most of the duplicated holes are identical, as are the elevations between tees and greens, though it was impossible to re-capture every fairway roll and subtle contour. Whatever the departures from the originals, the course plays, looks and feels like a pure Donald Ross design, providing a stern test that rewards fine play.

# The Arthur Hills

Boyne Highlands – Est. 1999



An Arthur Hills signature course, The Hills at Boyne Highlands starts out fairly unassuming with classic Arthur Hills design features such as wide fairway landing areas sprinkled with bunkers to narrowing approaches with fascinating green complexes.

It is after you make the turn that the real character of the design plays out. The 11th hole, a lengthy par-5, begins a three hole ascent to one of the highest points in the region and the magnificent view

from the 13th tee. The round finishes in proper fashion with a 577 yard monster of a par-5 (shown above) that is reachable in two for the brave long hitters.

As soon as The Hills burst onto the northern Michigan scene, it became a must play for its brilliant design, course conditions and photogenic good looks; all of which were showcased on the Golf Channel's hit series—Big Break X: Michigan
